The stories of torture in these prisons are widespread. One Montagnard man I have known for years tells me of his brother who is imprisoned in Vietnam. The Montagnards bribe prison guards to visit their people. His story goes, "He only have one leg now. He crazy from all of the electrical shock". The Bunong church has tremendous infrastructure. They are working first for approval, and then to pay for their flights here, under governmental requirements, the Bunong church has to provide Housing, Food, and Employment for these families when they arrive here. **Montagnard Project is matching our donation so a total of \$2400 will be used for this cause!**
